

When the Doctors are on duty cover they are not able to deal with routine matters. You can book a non-urgent appointment up to 28 days in advance. Our receptionists are specially trained to fit you in with the most appropriate consulter, be it a doctor, nurse or healthcare assistant. Please help us by being prepared to answer a few general and non-intrusive questions regarding why you need to be seen. 


