My name is Elizabeth Baxter (nee Wilby). I'm asking if anyone in Great Tey or thereabouts has heard of an Ethel Raven.

She was my Grandmother on my father's side (Mons Wilby). I would love to see a picture of her if anyone has one. All the pictures the family had of her were destroyed by my stepgrandmother.

Ethel was born to George and Eliza Raven, she had several brothers. According to the 1901 census she was 14 years old. In 1910 she married Alfred William Wilby in the parish of Great Tey. They had three children George, Mons and Amy. When they were small their mum Ethel was sent to Severals Hospital.
